Deodorizing Skunk Spray

The following formula is well proven to minimize or eliminate the odor from dogs that have been sprayed by a skunk.

Formula for deodorizing a skunk-sprayed pet:

For a small dog:

1 cup of 3% hydrogen peroxide
1 tbsp. baking soda
and 1/4 tsp. liquid soap.

For a large dog:

1 quart of 3% hydrogen peroxide
1/4 cup baking soda
and 1 tsp. liquid soap.

You could add an extra quart of water to this if your dog is very large.

Bathe the affected areas with the mixture. The bath should be followed by a thorough tap water rinse. This mixture will not affect the hair coat.

This formula has been used successfully on Rhodesian Ridgebacks that were sprayed as they were getting in their motor home to go to a dog show. The owner was still willing to travel in the motor home with the dogs immediately after their baths in the skunk spray formula!
